FOR NON-PARTISAN/INDEPENDENT/DECLINE-TO-STATE-VOTERS

I am a poll worker and I just today attended our training session for the primary. Something wonderful has been changed. A little background info: each primary election, the parties are asked if they will permit the non-partisan voters to vote on their primary. This year, ONLY the <u>DEMOCRATIC PARTY</u> and the American Independent party (this is a nasty one-look it up!) will allow them to do so. None of the other parties allow it.

In the past, the non-partisan voter had to request the ballot if he/she wanted to vote in one of those primaries. This year, they have added something super. The ROSTER CLERK (the first person you see in the polling place, will know if you are a registered non-partisan (Decline To State) voter; that information is printed in the roster. If you are, they must ask you if you want to vote for the Democratic or American Independent candidates.

This is a *wonderful* change for 2 reasons: 1. the voter doesn't have to remember to ask for a special ballot; the choice will be <u>offered</u>. 2. Some voters may not have realized that they had that choice and may be excited to know they can vote Democratic. LET YOUR INDEPENDENT FRIENDS KNOW THIS!

Non-partisan voters who do NOT to do that will receive a ballot with no names, only Propositions.

DAA SERVES HOMELESS SHELTER MEAL

On Sun. night, we prepared and served a meal to 35 people at the SCV Cold Weather Emergency Shelter. Our menu was Turkey chili with cheddar cheese and sour cream, green salad, corn muffins, milk and water, chocolate and vanilla pudding. It was a cold, rainy night. We waited on the clients and there were many requests for seconds and thirds!


