These folks were members of Christ Lutheran Church on Tournament Road which was a member of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America.

In 2008, at their national Convention, the ELCA passed a resolution welcoming gays and lesbians into their church community. Christ Lutheran, led by their current pastor, chose to leave the ELCA. The folks who are now holding their worship services at St. Stephen's wanted themselves and their families to attend an all-inclusive church, so they left Christ Lutheran, formed their own Congregation, Living Faith Lutheran, and have been holding services at St. Stephen's ever since.
