On Tuesday, March 31, the School Board agreed to postpone a vote on employee layoffs pending further investigation of alternative measures to balance the District's budget. The vote was rescheduled for the next school board meeting on April 14.

The District plans to spread the federal stimulus money over the next two years **rather than using it all up front, NOW, when it would save thousands of jobs, as Congress and the President intended.** We must speak up against the devastating effect of this ill-conceived decision on people's lives, on class size, on school reform, and consequently on our students, especially in the highest-needs schools.

It is crucial that we come out in force to the April 14 meeting and demand that LAUSD use all the federal stimulus money **NOW**, before **ANY** layoffs are implemented.
