**Parking for Union Station  
Gateway Parking \$6 /Car**

*To Gateway Garage:*

**From Alameda going North:** turn **R** on Cesar Chavez and **R** on Vignes and **R** to underground garage

**From Alameda going South:** **L** on Cesar Chavez and **R** on Vignes and **R** to underground garage

**From Sunset-Cesar Chavez going East:** **R** on Vignes

**From Cesar Chavez going West:** **L** on Vignes and **R** to garage entrance

Distance from garage to Event Spaces = approximately 250 yards

*(This walking space is inside, and takes you through Union Station. It is safe, well-lit, and is guarded by Security 24/7)*
