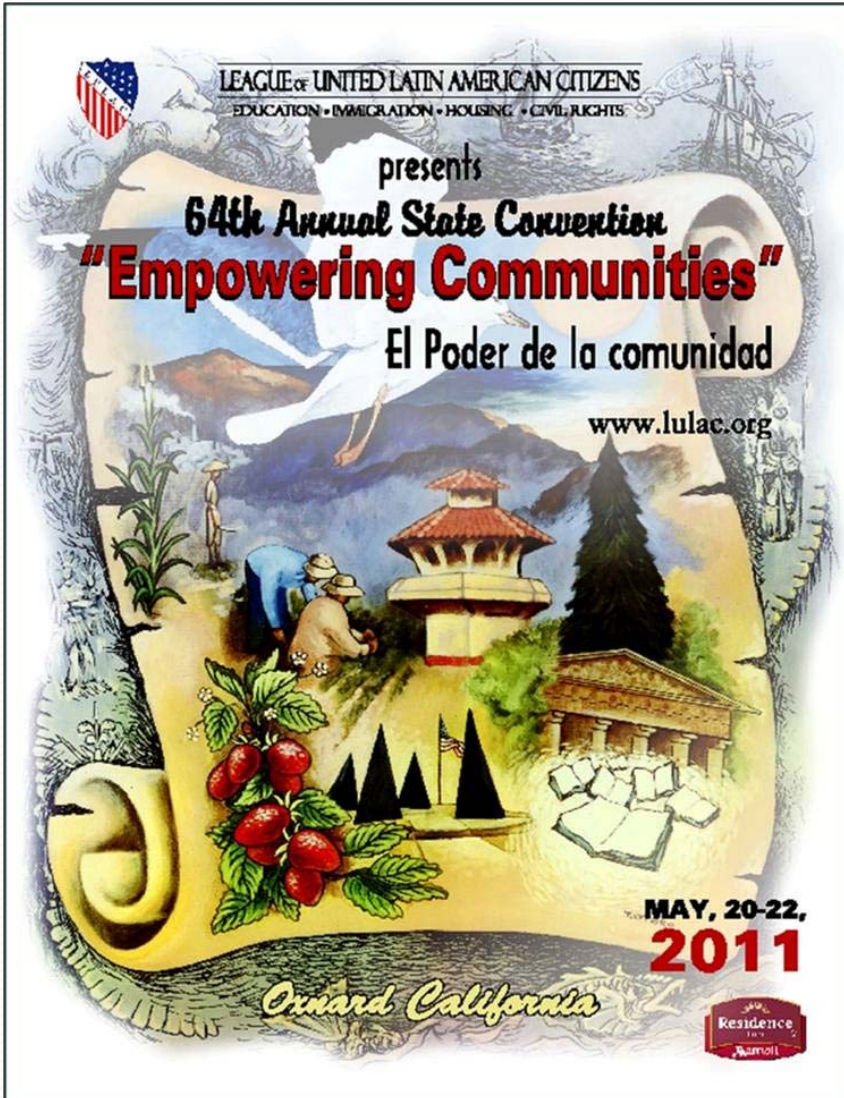

**DIRECTIONS TO HOTEL**

**From Los Angeles: take the 101 Freeway North to Oxnard, exit at Vineyard Avenue and turn left on to Vineyard Ave and proceed approximately 1.5 miles. Hotel is on your right.**

**From Northern California: take the 101 Freeway South to Oxnard, exit at Vineyard Avenue and turn right on to Vineyard Ave and proceed approximately 1.5 miles. Hotel is on your right.**

**From Central California: take I-5 to CA 118 West. Proceed past Moorpark (highway becomes CA 33) to 101 Freeway North (Ventura). Take the 101 Freeway North to Oxnard, exit at Vineyard Avenue and turn left on to Vineyard Ave and proceed approximately 1.5 miles. Hotel is on your right.**
