Prominent Westlake philanthropist **Richard Moscarello** (pictured) will share pictures and observations from his March 2009 visit to Gaza City. During that time Moscarello joined doctors, nurses and other relief workers from around the world working in Dar Al Shifa Hospital "trying to bring some normalcy to an abnormal situation." The March trip was the fifth time that he has gone to either Gaza or the West Bank.

The purpose of this presentation is to educate and share impressions that will open hearts and minds. The perspective will be humanitarian rather than political. Mr. Moscarello doesn't intend to argue "history" or discuss who is right or wrong.
