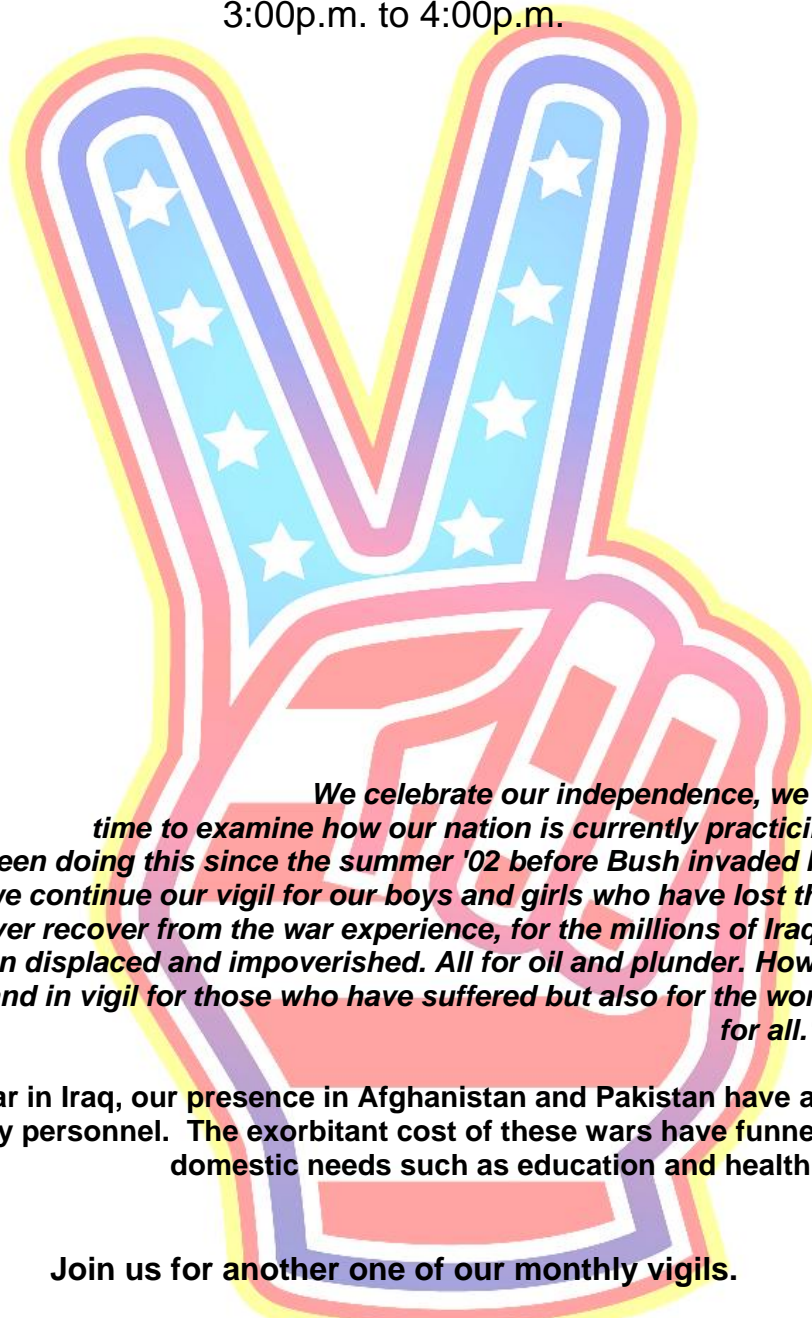


Grandmothers and Others for Peace!
