“Declaring Independence From Corporate Rule”

David Cobb, national spokesperson for the MoveToAmend campaign, will lead a community dialogue about this growing movement for democracy in the United States.

He will illustrate how unelected and unaccountable corporations have hijacked our government and describe the national coalition of diverse public interest, community, and business organizations which has issued a bold call to amend the U.S. Constitution to restore the power of people over corporations. Cobb will explain that the movement to amend our constitution is a result of the January 21, 2010 Supreme Court ruling, in Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission, that corporations are persons--entitled by the U.S. Constitution to buy elections and run our government. He will argue that since human beings are people and corporations are legal fictions, the Supreme Court is misguided in principle, and wrong on the law. And, that as a democracy, we, the people, can amend our Constitution to restore our rights. This is a **free** public program held at:
