The MCCN-Black Infant Health Program (BIH)

The MCCN-Black Infant Health (BIH) program focuses on improving the health of African American families in the San Fernando Valley. The program focuses on and is specifically funded for African American women because African American babies die at a rate 2 to 3 times higher than other ethnic groups. BIH works with African American mothers in a culturally sensitive and friendly way to share health education materials and community resources. We visit the mothers in their homes and organize events for our clients at our office. All of our work is focused on empowering our clients and finding solutions to lower the infant mortality rates in the African American community.

General Description: This is a very important position within the organization. The “CHOW” goes out into the community to find and enroll African American women into the program. The “CHOW” works with the client to provide health education and conducts in-home visits.

The person we hire for this position needs to be an expert in African American cultural norms and values. You will need to be comfortable in approaching African American women in community settings such as a beauty supply store, at church or perhaps even walking down the street. You must be warm, enthusiastic and self-motivated. The person we seek is comfortable speaking to strangers and is not afraid of rejection. You are comfortable visiting our African American clients in their homes. You are capable of speaking in larger group settings. You should have excellent communication skills, both verbal and written.
