invites women to participate in Green Careers for Women Training**

The WINTERGREEN Careers for Women Training targets women who want to start their nontraditional career while also becoming educated, aware and trained in Green Building, Environmental Remediation and GREEN ENERGY EFFICIENT Construction. WINTERGREEN Careers for Women Training is a ten week training that requires the trainee to fully participate and attend all ten weeks of the training. The training schedule is five days a week with mandatory 40 hours of completion per week.

WINTER provides intensive workplace competency skills, pre-apprenticeship construction trades introduction, environmental remediation training and other nontraditional career instruction, thus making our participants knowledgeable and marketable to the nontraditional trades.

General Qualifications to become a WINTER participant:

- Legal right to work in the United States
- Physically able to work in a physically demanding environment (lifting, standing, pulling, loading, unloading, and moving)
- Desire to enter a nontraditional career (environmental technician, electrician, plumber, cement mason, operator engineer, carpenter, insulator, lineman and many more trades)
- Women who are reliable, motivated, with a positive attitude, resourceful and communicative

Desired qualifications but not required:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid California Driver License
