Eligibility Requirements

Age and Document Requirements

16-24 years old only

Driver's License, or Government ID or Birth Cert or U.S. Passport and Social Security Card

Out-Of-School (**Required** –See Below for Exemption)

School Letter/Documentation, School Transcripts, Applicant Statement (25% Exemption—Basic skills deficient 8th grade level or below Referral from a HS Counselor or Teacher/Principal)

Student Must Meet at Least One of the Following Eligibility Categories:

Low-Income (Bring pay stub, bank statement, written statement of individual providing temporary residence, parents or self tax return, public assistance records, unemployment records)

Youth In Foster Care (Court documentation, social service contact, medical card)

Youth/Adult Offender (Court, group home/residential, police records, letter from parole/probation, applicant statement)

Youth with Disability (SSA disability, academic, IEP, medical records or physician statement)

Child of Incarcerated Parent (Court records, applicant statement)
